

ORDINANCE NO. 2013-03
AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 5.02, REGULATION
OF STREETS, SUBDIVISION 6, PARKING REGULATIONS, BY
ADDING A PROHIBITION OF PARKING ON A PUBLIC STREET
IN EXCESS OF 48 HOURS AND PROHIBITING PARKING OR STORING
OF UNLICENSED, UNREGISTERED, OR INOPERABLE VEHICLES &
JUNK ON PUBLIC OR PRIVATE PROPERTY.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TRIMONT DOES ORDAIN:

Section 1. Section 5.02, Regulation of Streets, Subdivision 6 is hereby amended to add the following addition sections:

- D. No person shall stop, park, or stand a motor vehicle on any highway, street or alley of the City for more than 48 consecutive hours. The violation shall be a petty misdemeanor.

- E. It is unlawful for any person to park or store any unlicensed, unregistered, or inoperable vehicle, household furnishings, appliances, scrap lumber, scrap or discarded building materials, other miscellaneous junk and accumulations not utilized in an active trade or business, on private or public property, unless housed within a lawfully erected building, or in a junk yard permitted by the City. The violation shall be a petty misdemeanor.
